The Personal Success Plan tool:

- Is an interactive, web-based, goal-setting tool that establishes student ownership of his / her education.
- Supports students in their identification and pursuit of social, academic, and ultimately economic goals, both short & long-term.
- Guides students as they create a living portfolio of both academic and personal goals associated with self-selected interests, role-models and career choices.
- Provides an integrated and stand-alone planning document, for use by *any* student, for creating time-based plans to meet *any* goal.

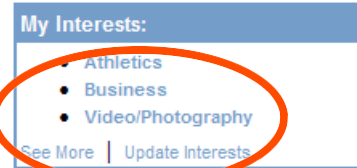

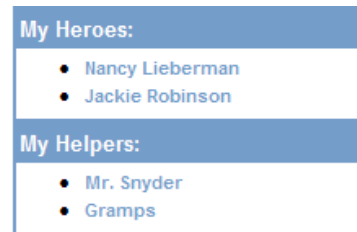
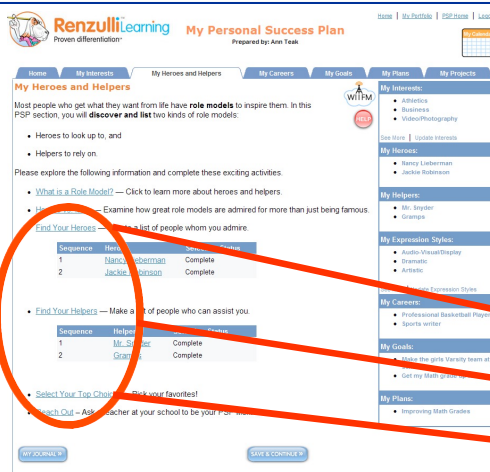
My Interests

My Heroes and Helpers

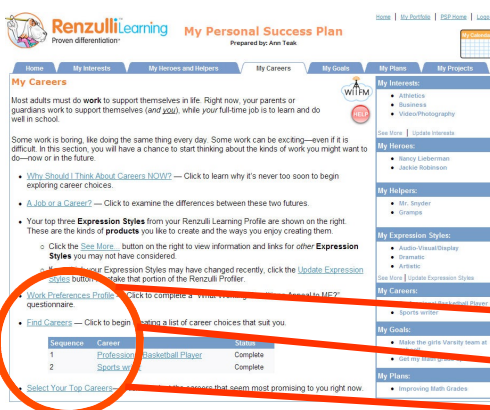
- The second task for students is to discover and list role models that inspire them.

My Careers

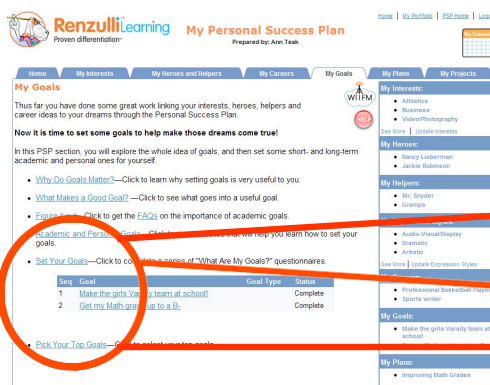
- The third task for students is to discover and list career possibilities.

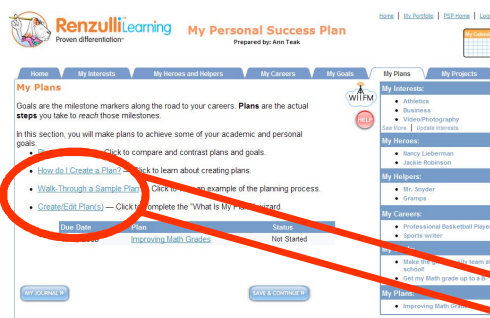

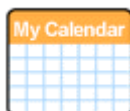
